# Your Benemax Health Plan® Summary of Benefits

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## PLAN DETAILS – BCBS HMO Blue NE Basic Co-pay With Benemax

The Benemax Health Plan<sup>®</sup> integrates a fully insured Blue Cross Blue Shield of Massachusetts (BCBS) component and an employer-funded component from Berkshire Family & Individual Resources (BFAIR) into a single benefit plan. The BCBS plan has an annual individual deductible of \$2,000 (\$4,000 family max). Members are responsible for the first \$1,000 per member (\$2,000 family max). BFAIR, via Benemax, pays the remaining plan deductible on your behalf, less applicable co-pays. In addition, the co-pays and co-insurance due after the deductible is met are also supplemented. Approved prescription drugs are covered at 100%.

Below is a brief reference of frequently used services and your final cost after your claims have been processed by both BCBS and Benemax.

Routine office visits & tests	No cost
Routine eye exam (1 every 24 months)	No cost
Diabetic management, first two visit PCP or specialist	No cost
Office visits by your PCP, OBGYN, Nurse Practitioner, Telemedicine	* \$25 co-pay
Office visits performed by Specialists or Chiropractor	* \$40 co-pay
Mental health or substance abuse treatment	* \$25 co-pay
Acupuncture visit (12 visits per year)	* \$40 co-pay
Urgent care	* \$40 co-pay
Emergency room visits (co-pay waived if admitted)	* \$150 co-pay
Services that apply to the deductible	Deductible: \$1,000 per Individual
Short-term rehabilitation therapy (up to 60 visits per calendar year)	* Deductible then \$40 co-pay
Day surgery in hospital, ambulatory or surgical day care facility	* Deductible, then no cost
Inpatient hospital services	* Deductible, then no cost
Diagnostic lab work (non-routine)	* Deductible, then no cost
Diagnostic x-rays (non-routine )	* Deductible, then no cost
Complex imaging (MRI/CT/PET)	* Deductible, then no cost
Durable medical equipment	* Deductible, then 20% co-insurance

#### Your plan requires you to:

- choose a primary care provider (PCP) from the HMO Blue New England provider network.
- obtain referrals from your PCP to see a specialist other than an OB/GYN.

## PRESCRIPTION DRUGS (RX)

Members will receive a Benemax Rx card at the beginning of the plan year. If you already have the Rx card, it will be reactivated for the new plan year. This card allows you to purchase prescription drugs that are approved by BCBS and CVS Caremark, BCBS's pharmacy benefit manager (PBM), **for zero copay**. \*\*Only BCBS prescription drugs are covered.

#### PillarRx Cost Share Assistance Program

Members who take an eligible medication can be eligible to get their medication for \$0-\$35 by using manufacturer's coupons. If you are taking an eligible medication, you will receive a letter and a phone call asking you to join the program. *Important!* Make sure you enroll; if you decline to enroll, you will be required to pay 30% of the cost of the medication.

#### For first time Rx Card users:

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Activate your card! Cards take 24-48 hours to fully activate. Rx refills ordered or charges made before allowing this activation time will result in card rejections.



At the pharmacy, present your BCBS ID card to ensure coverage, then use your Rx Card to pay the balance due. The card functions as a credit card or you can set up a pin during activation. Pay for your Rx separately from any other items. \*\*You can only use the Rx Card for BCBS approved prescription drugs. **Buyer beware**, the card will work for Rx drugs that are not covered under your BCBS medical plan. Post audits are conducted. You will be asked to repay the plan for any Rx that was not covered by BCBS

### HOW YOUR HEALTH PLAN WORKS

The chart below will help you understand who pays for what and when.



**You or a member of your Family** visits your provider (doctor/ hospital) and shows both their BCBS ID card and their Benemax Card. <u>Click here</u> to learn more about why showing your Benemax card is important

Your Doctor or Provider will bill BCBS.

**BCBS** will process your claim, notify your provider, and send a Claims Summary to you and your provider.

**Benemax** receives a report of your claims from BCBS. Benemax reviews your claim and makes additional payments on behalf of your employer.



Benemax posts a Benemax Explanation of Benefits (EOB) on your <u>Claims Connection</u> portal. You are responsible to pay the amount due to your provider as shown on the Benemax EOB.

When you receive your BCBS claims summary or a provider bill, log in to <u>Claims Connection</u> to view your member responsibility as stated on the Benemax EOB before making a final payment to your provider.

## **TELEHEALTH SERVICES**

Your BCBS plan also includes coverage for certain medical and behavioral health services via telehealth online video visits. You can consult with medical professionals, 24/7/365, and schedule convenient behavioral health visits right from your mobile device or home computer. These services are for conditions that can be treated through video visits such as bronchitis, sinus infections, pinkeye, or for behavioral health issues such as depression, anxiety, sleep difficulties and more. To access BCBS's national telehealth service provided by Well Connection, download BCBS' My Blue member App or register at https://member.bluecrossma.com/login.

Telehealth visits are charged at time of service. The cost for a visit is consistent with the cost of an in person visit to the provider type you see (PCP/Specialist). Benemax will automatically reimburse the cost of a BCBS approved Tele- health visit to the extent that it exceeds the member's cost shown on your benefit page. 
